- Jimmy H. Hill began his career with the Los Angeles City Fire Department on July 22, 1973. His 38-year tenure has included positions in Fire Prevention as the Deputy Chief of the Bureau of Fire Prevention and Public Safety; Section Commander of the Industrial Section; and Unit Commander of Public Safety (Schools and Churches Unit); and the Plan Check Unit.
- Chief Hill is a member of the National Fire Protection Organization (NFPA), International Fire Chiefs Association, the Southern California Fire Prevention Officers Association, and served as President of the International Fire Marshals Association of North America (IFMA). Additionally, he served 6 years as a State Commissioner on the California Building Standards Commission.
- Chief Hill has held a variety of Special Duty assignments; most notably that of the Fire Marshal for the City of Los Angeles. As Fire Marshal, Chief Hill approved plans and supervised Fire and Building Code enforcement over major new construction projects in the City of Los Angeles; such as, the Nokia Center, Staples Arena, LA Convention Center, Central Library, and numerous South Park development projects.
